## 1. Introduction

This document is developed as part of the BINGO (Bringing INnovation to onGOing water management – a better future under climate change) project, which has received funding from the European Union’s Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation programme, under the Grant Agreement number 641739. The Combined Dissemination Events report represents Deliverable 7.6 of Work Package 7 (WP7) – Dissemination, communication and exploitation. It also corresponds to the Milestone 31 – Dissemination Events held.

WP7 has three main objectives: (i) to disseminate and communicate project related information to the different target groups; (ii) to ensure that the results of the project are exploited and have a lasting impact in Europe; and (iii) to empower stakeholders to take up the project results. The specific objectives of this WP are to:

- Develop and update a Dissemination and Communication Plan, which will ensure an effective communication within and outside the project;
- Develop dissemination and communication materials and tools;
- Organise workshops to disseminate the project results and activities;
- Contribute to long term and sustainable engagement of stakeholders, maximizing the impact of the project;
- Create synergies with other projects and initiatives, contributing to an effective use of resources;
- Ensure an effective exploitation of the project results.

This report collects all the events on which BINGO has been represented, including project events and external events, since the beginning of the project. It is organised in the following sections:

- **Project events**, where the workshops at the research sites, the local dissemination events and ECCA 2019 are described;
- **Participation in external events**, where all the external events where BINGO was present are analysed and listed.

## 2. Dissemination and engagement events

### 2.1. Project events

The events which were organised, or will be organised, by the project where dissemination of BINGO has occurred or will occur are divided in three main categories:

- Workshops, organised in the six research sites (Norway, The Netherlands, Germany, Cyprus, Spain and Portugal) with local Communities of Practice' members, held at the six national languages
- Dissemination events at the research sites, organised by the Communities of Practice's members within the scope of the workshop activities (also held at the national language)
- ECCA 2019, that is currently being organised within the scope of T7.3 – Organisation of dissemination activities, where BINGO's Final Conference will take place in May 2019, in Lisbon, Portugal.

#### *Workshops*

A total of 25 workshops have been facilitated at the 6 research sites: 3 in Badalona (ES), 4 in Bergen (NO), 4 in Peristerona River Basin (CY), 6 in Tagus River Basin (PT), 4 in the Veluwe (NL) and 4 in Wupper River Basin (DE).

These workshops relate to the Communities of Practice roadmap, and have included the presence of almost 600 participants from different sectors and multi-level intervention vocations. These workshops have a strong engaging dynamic, not only showing BINGO's progression and results, but also bringing the stakeholders into the process.

#### *Dissemination events at the research sites*

Within the scope of the local Communities of Practice, the actions that have occurred (or can still occur) from the workshops were dissemination and engagement actions, focused on raising awareness to the impact of climate change on water resources, based on the work developed in BINGO for their own contexts.

As an example, some of the concrete actions that were decided in the Lisbon's Workshop #6, which took place in October 2018, were:

**TASK FORCE** (measures 4 and 5)

Opportunities and objectives:

- **Policy briefing** and meeting with the ministry of the environment
- **A government council**
- An **inter-ministerial commission** regarding an exhaustive inventory of the uses and availability of water supplies;
- Meetings with **parliamentary groups**.

(these objectives should be mobilized taking into account the opportunity of WATER DAY, March 22)

**OPEN DEBATE** (measures 10 and 25)

Opportunities and objectives:

- Debates '**Let's talk about water**'
- **Multimedia Product**
- Contacts with **local radios**
- **Muppies** in local supermarkets

(these objectives should be mobilized taking into account the opportunity of WATER DAY, March 22)

**GUIDED TOURS** (measures 15 and 22)

Opportunities and objectives:

- Link the **water issues** to citizenship one in school sessions
- Exhibition of **BINGO Video** in schools
- **Guided tours** to water infrastructures and local rivers (where does the water come from? Come and visit our river)

(these objectives should be mobilized taking into account the opportunity of WATER DAY [sessions at school], and guided tours will be held the following day, March 23rd, involving the families of the children)

**SCHOOL ACTIVITIES** (measures 13 and 21)

Opportunities and objectives:

- **Video exhibition** of partners and managers of the water sector (EPAL, ADP ...)
- **School Games** alluding to water issues
- Specific **class session** in a local school (Azambuja / Santarém)
- **Exposition** alluding the Water Day

(these objectives should be mobilized taking into account the opportunity of WATER DAY, March 22, and in close association with others events such as Guided Tours and the Open Debates – see above)

Each Community of Practice has evolved differently, exploring different dynamics and ways to work together. As such, the workshops have developed different structures and not all have the same needs or timings. The 5th round of workshops is ongoing. These gather the stakeholders in order to understand how to move forward with what was developed during the Communities of Practice's experience. The result of these workshops will include the organisation of dissemination activities, corresponding to Task 7.3 - Organisation of dissemination activities (WP7), but which will take different formats according to the research site.

## ECCA 2019

BINGO's final conference will be embedded in the European Climate Change Adaptation Conference 2019 (ECCA 2019), which will take place in 28-31 May 2019 in Lisbon. The date was chosen to be end-to-end to the ECCA event – for a better use of resources - and by voting in a doodle platform, as best fit most of the team. ECCA 2019 is a unique opportunity to share the BINGO project's achievements with the large audience of the conference and to give emphasis to the impact and exploitation in several stakeholder dimensions: scientific, governance, industry and society.

During the 3rd annual progress meeting, Cyprus, May 2018, the project members engaged in an interactive exercise in order to define the BINGO messages in ECCA and how to fit them in the conference themes. It was defined that BINGO is a process, not a product. The results of this exercise were then analysed and refined by the project coordination to serve as guidelines for the project's participation in ECCA.

Additionally, a Group for Internal Revision (GIR) was selected, composed by high-level members of the project, and supported the revision of the abstract submission to ensure that BINGO's representation in ECCA is complete and that it engages in appropriate synergies with other relevant projects in sessions and presentations.

The BINGO GIR has selected 22 abstracts from the suggested 28 abstracts, including merging of some of the contributions, following an analysis of the BINGO's outputs. These abstracts have been submitted to the ECCA 2019 registration platform.

### **2.2. Participation in external events**

The BINGO partners also take part in international and local conferences/meetings outside the project in order to disseminate the project and raise attention around the BINGO project and its findings. A list of activities is presented below in which project partners participated and where BINGO project was disseminated.

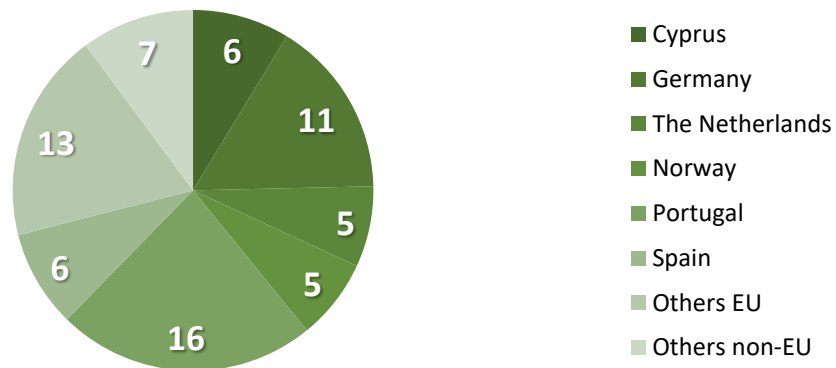
The project partners will continue to attend to external events throughout the project's lifetime and afterwards, disseminating BINGO's findings and promoting their exploitation.

The BINGO project has been represented in 70 events, reaching over 72 000 people. The geographical coverage of the events where BINGO has participated has been the following:

The partners within the BINGO consortium have engaged in the dissemination of the BINGO project in external events both in the countries involved in the project (Cyprus,

Germany, The Netherlands, Norway, Portugal and Spain) where there are BINGO research sites, and in countries outside the scope of BINGO.

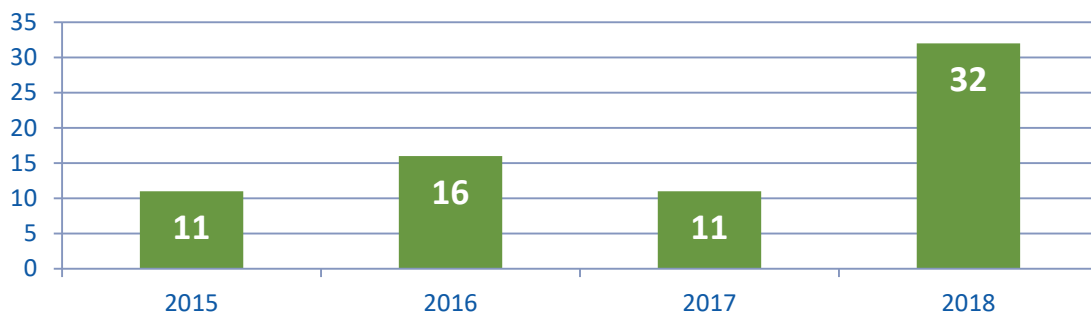
As the figure below displays, there have been a total of 49 external events within the project's involved countries where BINGO was represented, either through presentations, posters or by the distribution of promotional materials.



Apart from the countries of the research sites, the BINGO project was represented in events in 20 countries. Within the EU, BINGO was represented in Belgium, Austria, Sweden, Slovenia, Greece, the UK, Czech Republic, France and Italy. Outside the EU, BINGO was represented in events in Vietnam, Jordan, USA, Brazil, South Africa, Iran and Serbia.

The remaining event was an online meeting, in which BINGO was presented to an audience of 30 people.

Throughout the project lifetime, there was a constant flow of external events to which BINGO partners attended. However, as displayed by the figure below, in 2018 the flow has almost tripled in relation to the previous year, reflecting the achievement of concrete results from the work in BINGO:

### 3. Final remarks

The objective of this report is to summarize all the events on which BINGO has been represented, including project events and external events, from the beginning of the project.

The **Project events** that already took place include 25 workshops, facilitated at the 6 research sites with engagement of a Community of Practice. The other external event reported is under preparation since 2017, is the ECCA 2019 to take place in Lisbon and co-organised by BINGO, where a high number of BINGO presentations are expected (22 abstracts and 3 sessions have been submitted)

ECCA 2019 is foreseen to have over 1200 participants from the 5 continents, and will be a great opportunity to disseminate BINGO final results and outcomes. A large presence of the BINGO team is expected, also increasing the impact of face to face dissemination.

The **Participation in external events** is represented by a large list of external events where BINGO was present. BINGO has been disseminated in 70 different events, in 5 continents, 22 countries, and reaching a target audience of a total of over 72 000 people.

The description of events and figures presented herein denote a very good, successful and engaged dissemination of the project BINGO since July 2015 (the start of BINGO).
